How to Apply the Nikzad Wood Cleaner

NOTES

- As always, wait at least 36 hours before applying soap to a recently oiled floor.
- What makes the NIKZAD Soap unique is that it contains coconut fats and soy which form a protective film and makes future cleaning easier.
- Use NIKZAD Master Soap for floors, in public or commercial areas, that require daily cleaning.
- If the floor appears to have a hazy appearance you may use a cotton cloth under the dust mop to polish the haze away.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Using lukewarm water, mix the NIKZAD Soap at a ratio of 1:40, and at a ratio of 1:20 for dirtier floors.
- Never clean oak floors with a ratio of more than 1:40.

SOAP MIXING SOLUTIONS:

- Using lukewarm water:
 - > 2 gallons water with 6.4 ounces (about 3/4 cup) of NIKZAD Soap
 - > 3 gallons water with 9.6 ounces (about 1 1/4 cups) of NIKZAD Soap
 - > 4 gallons water with 12.8 ounces (1 1/2 cups) of NIKZAD Soap

PRE-APPLICATION NOTES

- Do not use too much soap or footprints will show on the floor. If this happens, use the NIKZAD Wood Cleaner.
- It is suggested to use the NIKZAD Sweep Mop to do the job. This mop is a high quality mop and has no loose ends.
- Always mop the floor using a damp mop head.

STEP 1

- Thoroughly sweep and or vacuum the wood floor first.

STEP 2

- 2 buckets
 - > Stir NIKZAD Soap with lukewarm water in one bucket; mix well.
 - > Pour only lukewarm water in the second bucket (as the rinse).

STEP 3

- Begin by cleaning an area of about 4' x 8' at a time.
- Soak the mop-head in the soap bucket then wring it out over the soap bucket.
- Mop the area side-to-side spreading the solution over the area.
- If a spot is overly soiled, allow an extra amount of soap to soak the area for a couple of minutes then come back with a dish-scrubbing brush.

STEP 4

- Rinse the mop well. Wring the mop-head over the rinse bucket.
- Do not apply the rinsed mop to the floor.

STEP 5

- Repeat Steps 1 – 4 until the floor is completely clean.
- Any spots that have droplets of water, should be wiped up with the mop.
